5	<ul> <li>GROUP / BRIGADE ISSUES</li> <li>Raised concerns about hygiene for such dirty sites such at Peates Soil and the eating in appalling conditions. This was raised with the group as a concern and we should monitor to see if this does not improve.</li> <li>Photo IDs out of date. The field uniforms assists but when asking for donations should be updated.</li> <li>CFSVA access to National Parks feedback. There seems to be a lot of CFS members booking a site and then not turning up. This feedback needs to go back to the Brigades.</li> <li>New Thermal Imaging Cameras are now being included on new structure appliances but it means that many of the previous structure appliances will not have an available TIC. Monitor as this has been raised within the group.</li> <li>Communications particularly with regards to Training is still problematic. Emerald is part of this problem and it may be solved with the new Emerald system.</li> </ul>
6	At present we believe that it is better to distribute the new flyers and ask such questions face to face within the Brigades. We are currently developing a new website for the CFSVA that will be merely a signup area and a place for people to raise issues and a tracking of these issues.
7	Suggestions for  - Holiday Parks or accommodation special rates including caravan parks. This would be very attractive for regional members.  - Monarto and Cleland for special concessions for CFSVA members.  - Retail and Hardware store mates rates.  - Sealink KI ferry.  Regionally we now have the Stirling 24 Fit Gym offering Mates rates of only \$1 joining fee instead of \$139 and a reduction of \$1 per program per week. Management group will continue to look at more local based services that may provide benefits to members. State wide benefits will need to be discussed at a State Level  Still considering publishing a new Fire Fighter booklet and a new induction kit and inviting Captains and leadership groups within each Brigade.
