		Issues were raised by several Brigade and Group representatives about the appalling unresolved issues at CFS facilities directly affecting the health of volunteers. These included sub-standard or non-existent toilets, inadequate or complete absence of air -conditioning, over-crowded engine bays and car- parks requiring hazardous shuffling of vehicles and other issues that have resulted in no action over several plaintive years.  IT WAS RESOLVED UNANAMOUSLY that: SAFEWORK SA is the appropriate body to action these critical issues and that this should be driven in the first instance by Sonia St Alban.  Moved: Geoff Cappur (R1 Ops), Seconded: Ivan Hosking  Richard raised the question of the removal of the requirement to appoint an OH&S brigade rep in the amendments to the Fire and Emergency act. The meeting considered it essential that this clause be reversed.  MOVED (Chris Lambert) SECONDED (Ivan Hosking) Action to be sought from Stack Stevens, State WH&OS Representative. UNANAMOUSLY carried.

10.	Report from Sonia St Albans	1. AVL Trials went well, feedback OK, on-time, tenders under way. Should be on all CFS Vehicles by '21/'22 Fire Season.  Question relayed from Peter Venning (MAWSON GP) by Secretary: is AVL to be used also by MFS? Answer YES- CFS.MFS and SES but not SAAS  Much general discussion:  -AVL will result in more workload down the chain of command and thus will not be helpful;  -it is useful only for CRIMSON, Incident Controllers & IMT;  -a huge expenditure when not all Brigades will use it.

6.	Volunteer Charter: Crown Solicitors refusing to accept changes so VA

7.	It has been agreed that the independent Chair of SAFECOM will be	
	appointed by the Minister in consultation with the VA.
